Mr. Mujeeb Rehman Dean of Frontline Academy

Mr. Mujeeb Rehman of Frontline Academy pointed out that with India aiming to become a US \$7 trillion economy by FV2030 the need for efficient logistics becomes paramount and crucial for its business and economy.

For efficient Logistics business needs an efficient and skilled workforce, which is very much essential for successful business and that which is not necessarily available to meet the industry requirements.

This gap between the need and supply of skilled manpower is increasing and this impact has caused and will create a huge dent in the industry, due to the low skill level of the current logistics workforce and the unavailability to provide skilled workforce due to the growing work demand.

Mr. Rehman viewed that the skilling of logistics professionals should be incorporated from the High school, by providing basic inputs and understanding of the logistics industry. Logistics & Shipping industry should be understood and taught as any professional program, as this industry plays a very major role in shaping the economy of the country to develop into its full potential.

The logistics industry should align with the institutes to meet their requirements and skill workforce. Active Participation by the Industry in teeming up requirements and modules required for the industry and skilling of the workforce and boosting the educational sector.

He also pointed out that there is a lack of initiatives among a large number of logistics companies & practitioners in acquiring/providing required training to themselves and to their staff and the main reason seeing emerging skilled staff as a threat rather than an achievement. In addition, there is no-acceptance of the challenges of new and emerging technologies in the market. Fear of losing the trained staff or investment in workforce training has been a major reason behind the nonavailability of the skilled workforce for replacement.
